



Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) Insurance

DESCRIPTION

- All Swimmers are required to sign-up as members of the Amateur Athletic Association (AAU) and obtain AAU Insurance before being admitted to any AMST practice or Meet.
 - ❖ This is an annual requirement.
- The AAU maintains an insurance program that provides coverage for its districts, member clubs/teams, and individual members conducting and/or participating in its sanctioned events.

- Swimmers must bring a copy of their AAU Membership Card with them for verification during initial Check-In on or before the First Day of Practice.
 - ❖ No swimmer will be allowed to practice or compete until a copy of their AAU Membership is on file.

Step-by-step Instructions for obtaining AAU Insurance

- Go to Web Site: www.AAUSports.org
- Click on icon: "Join AAU Now"
Click on icon: "ATHLETE, Purchase a 2010 ATHLETE Membership"
- New window opens
- Enter: Swimmer Information as requested
Select Step 1: "Youth Program"
Select Step 2: "Membership expires August 31, 2010. Regular Membership 12.00"
Select Step 3: "Swimming"
Enter Club Name: Anderson Mill Swim Team
Enter Code: STSW5TAKB0
Click: "Yes" or "No" for Health and Accident Insurance
- Click: "Save and Continue"
Click: "Add an Athlete" or "Finish" as appropriate
- Select Free T-Shirt: Be advised there is a Shipping Charge.
Click: "Push to add this T-Shirt" once for each T-Shirt is selected.
- Click: "Click Here to Finish"
Enter: Billing Information as requested
Click: "Continue" and wait for online processing to complete
- Print: The displayed web page containing your membership cards and receipt.
- Bring: AAU Membership Card(s) to first practice.
