



SCORER

DESCRIPTION

- The SCORERS receive Event Cards, calculate Swimmer's times, post times and support the RIBBON COORDINATOR in determining Swimmer Ribbon awards.

REQUIREMENTS

- Four (4) SCORERS, two (2) SCORERS per each half Meet, is required for each Dual Meet, Home and Away. A SCORER should not be changed unnecessarily during either half of the Meet.
 - ❖ One (1) SCORER per Team per half Meet shall be identified as the LEAD SCORER.
 - ❖ The LEAD SCORERS are responsible for verifying that the official Meet Heat Sheet has been turned in at the Ribbons and Scoring Table by the Start of the Meet.
- SCORERS are not required to participate in Swim Circuit's Official Clinic training. It is the responsibility of each Team to train their SCORERS.
- Official Swimmer Event Heat Times are calculated as follows:
 - ❖ The median average of the three (3) times recorded by the TIMERS shall be the official time.
 - ❖ If a Swimmer's Heat Time is not available, it is so marked on the Event Card, where applicable, and the median average is calculated from the remaining recorded Swimmer's times.
 - ❖ If one (1) of the Swimmer's time is one second (1.0) or more higher or lower than the other two (2) times, the higher or lower time will be thrown out, and the remaining times will averaged to determine the official time.
- The Event Cards are the primary official record for Post Seasonal Meet eligibility and seeding times and must be retained by each Team until the end of the Current season.

DUTIES

- The SCORERS and MEET RIBBON COORDINATORS receive and organize the Event Heat Cards and Disqualification Forms (DQ) delivered by the RUNNERS.
- The SCORERS and RIBBON COORDINATORS will identify the official time for each Swimmer in an Event and determine the official order of finish in each Event according to the official Swimmer's time calculated and posted.
 - ❖ SCORERS and RIBBONS COORDINATORS from both Teams assist in verifying the computer data during the Meet.
- Once the Swimmer's official time has been determined, that time is written on the Event Card, where applicable.
 - ❖ The completed Event Cards, where applicable, are used to enter the Swimmer's time into the computer.
 - ❖ If an Event Card has a Disqualification (DQ) Form attached, the SCORERS will verify the DQ Forms for proper initialing and organize them with the Event Cards with the proper Heat.



- The Home Team is responsible for entering the Swimmer data in to the computer and must ensure that the entry of the Swimmer names, finish times and any other data is accurate and complete.
 - ❖ The computer application automatically assigns the lowest Swimmer time as 'First Place'; the second lowest Swimmer time as 'Second Place'; and so on
 - ❖ Any Event Card without times or that have a DQ Form attached are not given an official place.
- At the end of the Meet, each Team's Event Cards, where applicable, along with all DQ Forms sorted by Event by Swimmer are returned to their respective Teams.
 - ❖ Each Team will receive a computer file of their Meet entries and results.
- For Dual Meets, RIBBONS COORDINATORs and SCORERs will keep an accurate count of the Team points as the Meet progresses, post official results as available, and be responsible for designating ribbon awards accurately.
